Dear WNSA Member or Interested Bowler,

Our next event is at Town Hall Lanes in Johnston, Rhode Island, on the weekend of August 6-7. We are excited to once again have a combined event with the DPBA. It leads to some exciting games and we always hear stories about what a great time people have at this annual event.

The entry fee for this event is \$80.00. There will be two qualifying shifts held on Saturday, August 6th, at 8:30 a.m. and 1:30 p.m. It is important to get your entries in by the deadline so we can make all of the necessary arrangements. With the automatic scoring system, we will be assigning lanes based on the postmark. If there is enough interest and entries received by the deadline, we will consider adding another shift to accommodate as many bowlers as possible.

Bowlers must check in at least 30 minutes prior to their shift time. It is the bowler's responsibility to be there on time to avoid a penalty. Shift assignments will be made on a first-come, first-served basis using the entry's postmark. The semi-finals will start at 10:00 a.m. on Sunday. The Governing Body will meet at 8:30 AM on Sunday at Town Hall Lanes.

Please complete the attached tournament entry form and return it to the address on the form. Entry forms must be postmarked no later than **Tuesday, July 26, 2011**. Entries postmarked after June 26 will incur a \$10 late fee. The shift and lane assignments will be posted on the WNSA web site.

We have a \$100 cash drawing at each tour stop at the start of the final qualifying shift, funded by a generous donor and supporter. All WNSA bowlers competing at this event are eligible. You could take home an extra \$100! Just ask Dani McClay, who was drawn at the White Oak event.

To give our members other options for payment, the WNSA can now accept credit and debit cards, along with PayPal, for entry and membership fees. There is a \$4.00 service charge for each US transaction and \$10.00 for each International transaction. These are necessary to cover the banking fees.
